CONSUMER PROTECTION (CERTIFICATE OF CONFORMANCE AND CONFORMITY MARK OF SAFETY STANDARDS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2013

IN exercise of the powers conferred by sections 19 and 150 of the Consumer Protection Act 1999 [*Act 599*], the Minister makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the **Consumer Protection (Certificate of Conformance and Conformity Mark of Safety Standards) (Amendment) Regulations 2013**.

(2) These Regulations come into operation on 1 September 2014.

Amendment of First Schedule

2. The Consumer Protection (Certificate of Conformance and Conformity Mark of Safety Standards) Regulations 2010 [*P.U. (A) 253/2010*] are amended in the First Schedule—

(a) in column (3) of item 1, in the English language text, by inserting after the words “who conduct” the word “goods”; and

(b) by inserting after item 1 the following item:
